SACRAMENTS

Baptism

Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life and the entryway which gives access to all other sacraments.

Please contact the pastor 3 months prior to preferred date for the sacrament

Marriage

The sacrament of matrimony gives spouses the grace to love each other with the love which Christ loves his Church. Please contact the pastor at least six months prior to your preferred marriage date.

Reconciliation

Catholics are encouraged to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation so that they may be well disposed to receive the other sacraments in a state of grace. This sacrament is available 30 minutes prior to Mass or by appointment.

Sacrament of the Sick:

This sacrament unites those who are about to undergo surgery, are seriously ill or are in danger of dying with Jesus' saving power. If you or someone you know would like to receive the sacrament, please contact the pastor.

If you, or a family member are hospitalized and wish to receive Holy Communion and/or a visit from a priest, at the time of admittance, please inform the hospital that you are Catholic.
