Advent is upon us, but what does this mean? How does this season bring us closer to God? Advent is defined as "The arrival of a notable person, thing or event". Our minds might be beset by many wonders vying for our attention. A.I. for instance is quickly becoming ubiquitous in many people's lives. The arrival of A.I. however, with its ability to provide for us an answer to any question we ask it, or to create something for us does not bring us closer to God, nor does it speed His arrival, or prepare us to receive Him. A.I. has no connection to the Holy Spirit. This applies to anything that is of the world. You are not of the world, nor is our Lord Jesus Christ. What God created in us must be made ready to receive God. Those preparations cannot come by way of the world.

Prepare your temple to receive the Word, the Truth that is Jesus Christ. Angels heralded the birth of our Lord. Ask your Guardian Angel to help you prepare to receive Jesus Christ in a way that you never have before. If the world is trying to pull you away from the Lord, renounce it, and withdraw from what you need to. Wait with hopeful expectation, and a faith that trusts in God's good intentions for you.

God is making Himself available to us in the person of Jesus Christ. Our gift to him is our personal availability. Is my mind, heart, soul, my whole person available to Him, orientated to Him in all things? Freed from all the new technological mediums? Advent leads to Christmas, a personal relationship with God.
