We can, with the help of a priest, spiritually purify our homes and bring the light of the Lord there too! 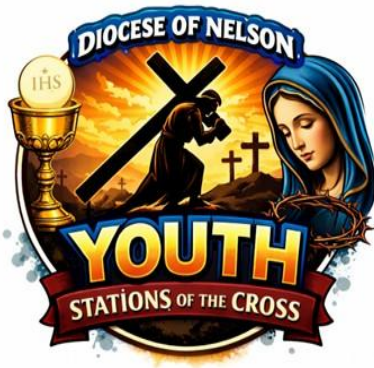
St. Ann's Academy Kamloops Alumni Homecoming 2026
