REFLECTION:

The Samaritans were "only baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus". Take a moment to reflect on the breathtaking statement that was given to us in Acts 8:16 "...only baptized". If anyone ever considered baptism the summit of Christian life and spirituality, they need only read this verse to know that it is only the beginning, a preparation of the "soil" of the soul if you will.

How many Catholics receive the Holy Spirit through confirmation, but then leave the faith, or stagnate? We learn from the Apostles that they had to pray that the Samaritans would be given this gift. Does anyone truly believe that this is where the efforts cease? Every confirmed Catholic needs to follow the example set by Peter and John and pray that the gift of the Holy Spirit be cultivated; and that prayer needs to be a daily, lifelong prayer. If baptism is the "soil preparation", then confirmation is the planting of a "seed".

Try an experiment. Instead of praying "come Holy Spirit", (which is worthy and did happen at your confirmation) be specific. Try something along the lines of "Holy Spirit, thank you for coming. Unfold in me and my life, and rule me, my heart and my soul with the Lord Jesus in accord with the holy will of God the Father, for His glory". Let something to this effect become a daily habit and submission, and find the path leads to the summit of Christian life and spirituality.
